Dear Mr Hassanin,

An official complaint has been filed against the leadership ticket headed by yourself.

I have been informed that Mr. Thomas Ginivan, current 1st Vice-President of the United Nations Staff Union and candidate to the same post in your ticket, sent the attached electronic mail on 02 June 2011 to the staff-at-large.

The complaint states that Mr. Ginivan used a computer located at the UNSU office to send the e-mail communication in question, which was then further distributed utilizing the list of e-mail addresses of staff members compiled by the UNSU office.

<u>Article 6.15.1</u> of the Regulations of the United Nations Staff Union states that, "No Union facilities shall be used for any campaign purposes throughout the entirety of the election process".

This action constitutes a clear violation of Article 6.15.1 of the UNSU Statutes and Regulations.

In view of the above, I request that you provide clarification immediately in order to avoid being disqualified from the race.
